# INSTRUCCIONES

*Nº de jugadores: un mínimo de 2 hasta 6. Lo ideal son 4.*

*Tiempo aproximado: 45 min.*

*Objetivo: El primero en completar una familia semántica, gana.*

*Destinado a alumnos de ciclo superior de primaria y de la ESO.*

*Antes de empezar el juego:*

Cada alumno tiene que tener un lápiz o un boli y una hoja de cuadrantes de familias.

Se mezclan las 168 cartas de palabras junto con las 8 cartas de acciones.

Una vez barajadas las cartas, un jugador coge una carta tapando con el dedo la respuesta, el jugador en turno tiene que ordenar las letras de la palabra y dibujarla en un minuto y medio. Luego, escribir la palabra en el cuadrante correspondiente de su hoja de seguimiento de las familias de palabras. Si acierta, puede continuar jugando cartas dentro de ese minuto y medio. Si le toca una carta de acción, la aplica y continúa jugando dentro de su tiempo. Una vez consumado el tiempo, pasa el turno al otro jugador. En el caso que fallara al ordenar las letras de la carta o al hacer el dibujo correspondiente, el tiempo se para y pasa el turno al siguiente jugador.
